I. BOUNDARIES

The boundaries of Cottage City are generally as follows:

From a point at the centerline of Bladensburg Road above the northern shoreline of the Anacostia River, then south along the centerline of Bladensburg Road to its intersection with the District of Columbia at Eastern Avenue, then northwesterly to the CSX railroad right-of-way, then north along the western side of the CSX right-of way to the northern shoreline of the Anacostia River. From that point east to the origination point at the centerline of Bladensburg Road.

II. AREAS OF SPECIFIC AND CONCURRENT JURISDICTION

The Cottage City Police Department has specific jurisdiction within the boundaries of the Town of Cottage City as specified above. Within those boundaries, the Cottage City Police Department has concurrent jurisdiction with the Prince George's County Police Department.

The Cottage City Police Department also has limited jurisdiction and police authority as specified in the various Memorandums and Mutual Aid Agreements that are in effect from time to time with the Towns of Colmar Manor, Edmonston, North Brentwood and Prince George's County.
