# ABSENTEE BALLOT



### Can I vote by absentee ballot?

Yes, if you are a registered voter in the Town and/or in Maryland.  
Only residents of the Town of Cottage City can vote in Town Elections.

### How do I request an absentee ballot?

Requests may be by mail, or in person, but must be in writing. Applications for absentee ballots may be obtained from the Town during business hours. All applications must have the signature of the registered voter.

If the Town of Cottage City receives your completed application by the deadline, the Town will issue you an absentee ballot. Again, the deadline to turn your application in is by Friday, May 3, 2019 by 5:00pm. The Town will **not** accept applications for absentee ballots Friday, May 3, 2019 after 5:00pm.

### ¿Puedo votar por voto en ausencia?

Sí, si usted es un votante registrado en la Ciudad y / o en Maryland. Solo los residentes de Town of Cottage City pueden votar en Town Elections.

### ¿Cómo solicito una boleta de votación en ausencia?

Las solicitudes pueden ser por correo o en persona, pero deben hacerse por escrito. Aplicaciones para Se pueden obtener boletas de votante ausente del Pueblo durante el horario comercial. Todas las solicitudes deben tener la firma del votante registrado.

**Mosquito Control Program:** The town is participating in the mosquito control program by the Maryland Department of Agriculture. We are scheduled for adult mosquito surveillance and possible spraying on Tuesday nights. The program will begin May 29, 2019 and run through September 17, 2019. Surveillance is done the following way: 3 female mosquitos in 2 minutes in a landing rate count or 24 female mosquitos in a baited light trap. This will influence the amount of spaying done for adult mosquitos. If you have any complaints, please obtain the following information for each complaint: address, problem area, time of day when mosquitos are the worst, and any area of stagnant water in their vicinity. Please contact the Town Hall so information can be forwarded to the proper management.

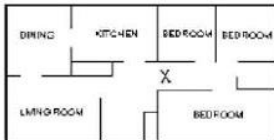

## PLEASE TAKE A MOMENT TO REVIEW AND PRACTICE THESE SAFETY TIPS

### HOME ESCAPE PLANNING

- Teach children how to dial **911** in an emergency.
- Have a written home escape plan and practice it.
- Practice two exits out of every room.
- Know how to open your windows.
- Crawl low under smoke.
- If your clothes catch on fire, stop, drop and roll.
- Touch the door for heat before leaving your room.
- Have a meeting location outside of your home.



### LIGHTING MATERIALS

- Keep all matches and lighters out of children's reach.
- Teach children to show you any unattended lighters and matches.
- Do not allow anyone to use lighters and matches in an unsafe manner.

### SMOKE ALARMS

- Install smoke alarms on every level in your home near the bedrooms.
- Check home smoke alarms once a month.
- Change smoke alarm batteries twice a year.

### HEAT SOURCES

- Teach children not to play in the kitchen or touch the stove.
- Never leave your cooking unattended.
- Never cook wearing loose clothing.
- Make sure the stove is off before leaving the kitchen area.
- When washing or bathing, always turn the cold water on first.
- Never leave small children unattended in the bathroom.
- Never leave your home while the clothes dryer is running.
