As you may be aware the Town of Cottage City Commission embarked upon a journey to acquire land adjacent to the Town Hall. The Commission is happy to announce that they are the winning bid for the property at 3813 Cottage Terrace. The property was won through a competitive bid process over the past week. The Town purchased the property with the intent to build a community center. The price was \$241,000. The closing date is set for September 20, 2019.

What does this mean for residents? This purchase creates certainty that the town can now take on the process of building a community center. The process will start with a series of town hall meetings to get the residents input on what activities they would like to see at the community center and how they would like it to look. No design has been determined at this point and the Commission would really like to hear your voice on the look of the building. Please stay tuned for more information to come in the next few weeks about the town hall meetings.

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWN OF COTTAGE CITY AMENDING CHAPTER 9 (TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES) OF THE CODE OF THE TOWN OF COTTAGE CITY REGARDING THE VARIOUS FINES BY AMENDING SECTION 9-11 TO PROVIDE A TABLE OF FINES FOR THE VARIOUS VIOLATIONS FOUND WITHIN THE PROVISIONS OF CHAPTER 9; BY PROVIDING FOR THE CHANGE OR MODIFICATION OF SAID FINES OR FEES BY WRITTEN RESOLUTION; AND GENERALLY RELATING TO THE REGULATION OF TRAFFIC AND VEHICLES
